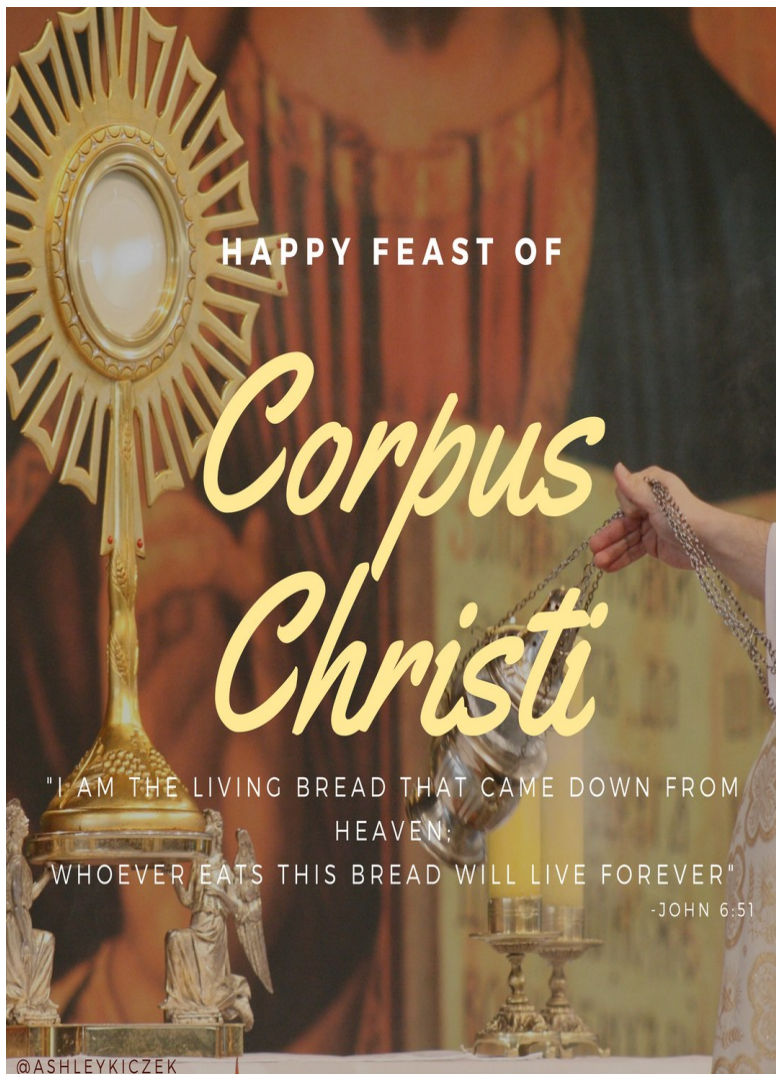

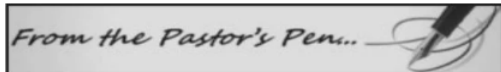

Dear Friends,

The Month of May is traditionally dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Now, June is upon us. The month of June is similarly dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. You will see billboards going up around town of the image of the Sacred Heart. This devotion in honor of the tender love and mercy of our Savior Jesus is rooted back to St. John Eudes and then St. Margaret Mary after him. The image of the Divine Mercy of St. Faustina from before WWII is a natural progression of the image of the Sacred Heart.

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart is on Friday, June 12th this year. Recently, the NCCB (National Council of Catholic Bishops) have overwhelmingly voted to consecrate the United States of America to the Sacred Heart of Jesus this June. They want to do this in celebration of America's 250th birthday. Consecration is a holy surrender. I, likewise, will be consecrating St. Mary's to the Sacred Heart at my Masses on Friday, June 12th. I believe the bishops are imploring America to return a similar love to our Savior as He has for us. Likewise, I encourage all of you to consecrate your homes and families to the Sacred Heart of Jesus this June. I also encourage all Catholic homes to erect an image of the Sacred Heart in a prominent place. ### EMHC & LECTOR FORMATION

We are happy to announce the next cycle of Archdiocesan Eucharistic minister (EMHC) and lector formation is now available. If you are already a mandated EMHC or lector but received your training in a different diocese, review of the current videos from the Omaha Archdiocese must be completed as well. All new EMHCs and lectors over the age of 19 MUST be Safe Environment certified before they can begin their ministry. The formation process consists of a combination of online Archdiocesan videos, which can be completed in the comfort of your own home at your own pace, and in-person tutorials at the parish level.

As always, eligible candidates must:

- Be fully initiated, meaning they have been Confirmed
- Be practicing Catholics
- Be in good standing with the Catholic Church
- Be affiliated with a parish
- Demonstrate responsibility and commitment to service
- Be at least a rising junior in high school

Thank you to all the players, sponsors, donors, and volunteers who participated in our golf outing last August. Now that a lot of the work has been completed, we would like to update you on what was accomplished with the proceeds.

Due to your generosity, much work was completed to restore our historic St. Mark's Hall. Railings were installed on the front entrance, electrostatic painting was completed on both sides and above the front door as well as on the window frame above the door, the stone was cleaned around the entrance as well as the scrolls and two spire tops, a new sign was installed above the front door, the old sign on the side of the building was replaced with a brand new one, and a new security light was installed on the southeast corner of the building. Inside St. Mark's, we replaced the blinds on all the windows. Additionally, through your generosity, we will fund a majority of the costs to repair and repaint the window frames around the entire St. Mark's building. This work is under contract and will be completed soon. When you get a chance, please take a look at St. Mark's Hall and enjoy these wonderful renovations.

To date, nearly \$70,000 has been made over the years from our golf outings for parish upgrades and projects. Again, thank you, thank you, thank you!

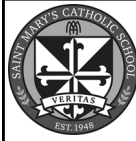
### PERPETUAL ADORATION

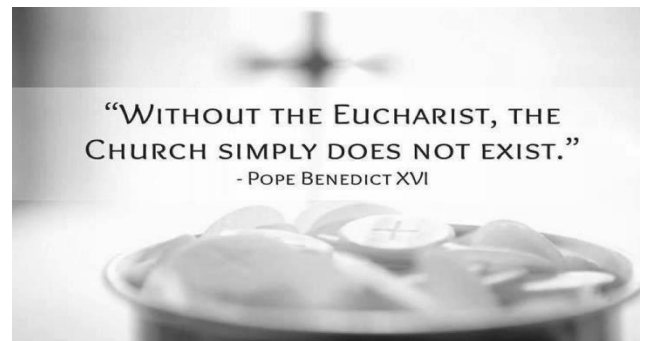
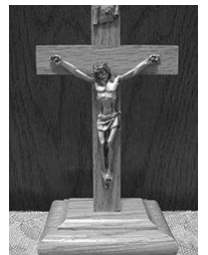

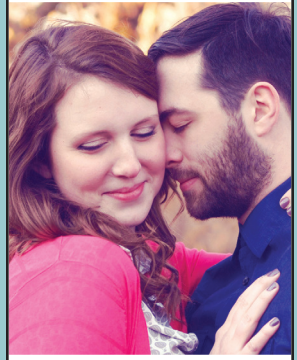
